10.0	44.0	Very highly epidotized andesitic material (?) cut by numerous quartz f.f.	
44.0	95.0	f.g., dk. greenish-black, andesite with minor disseminated magnetite, locally deflects Brunton needle up to 25°. Scattered epidote and zoisite (?) f.f., locally amygdaloidal. Locally sl. schistose parallel to core.	
95.0	194.0	Similar, somewhat less magnetic and cut by numerous pink carbonate and epidote f.f., locally somewhat biotite.	
194.0	274.0	Mostly f.g., dk. green andesite cut by occasional quartz, epidote and carbonate f.f. and locally amygdaloidal, may be tuff in part. ground core as follows: 254-255, 255.5-258.5, 260, 261, 261.6-262.0, 266.0-266.5, 270.7 - 271.3. Locally schistose at 30°.
