14.8	22.5	Coarse-grained, pink to grey granite, highly siliceous
22.5	46.3	Fine-grained, dark grey-black, dolerite dyke, occasional calcite fracture-fillings. 27.0 - 29.0 - core ground
46.3	112.1	Fine-grained ^{to} medium-grained dark grey-black granite, biotite, plagioclase and amphibole prevailing, with occasional pyrite specks. Likely an alteration phase due to the dyke intrusion. Lower contact 82° with core axis. 48.0 - 49.3 - dolerite dyke.
112.1	156.0	Fine-grained dark grey-black dolerite dyke. 130.0 - 166.0 core badly broken up and in places ground.
156.0	284.2	Coarse-grained, pink to grey granite, same as 14.8-22.5, but in places altered due to dyke intrusions

284.2	289.7	Fine-grained, dark grey-black dolerite with granitic inclusions
289.7	333.9	Fine-grained - medium-grained dark grey to pink granite, with occasional epidote development.
333.9	364.2	Fine-grained, dark grey-black dolerite dyke
364.2	372.7	Medium-grained, pink to white-grey granite. Lower contact 25° with the core axis
372.7	373.0	Fine-grained, dark grey-black, dolerite dyke.
