89.0	139.8	Fine grained dark grey-black Hornblende andesite with occasional epidote bands and minor pyrite and pyrrhotite locally. Strike of 35° with core axis.
139.8	161.3	Fine grained to medium grained, medium grey-black Hornblende diorite with ophitic texture and chilled contact. Upper contact makes an angle of 85° with the core axis.
161.3	213.9	Fine grained dark grey-black andesite and minor interbedded silicic tuff with varying amounts of pyrite, pyrrhotite and chalcopyrite locally.
213.9	247.7	Fine grained medium to dark grey tuff, highly silicic, with numerous quartz fracture-fillings, some carbonate developed and minor pyrite, pyrrhotite and chalcopyrite locally.
247.7	249.9	Fine-grained black trap.
249.9	293.0	Tuff similar to 213.9-247.7.
293.0	310.0	Fine grained, dark grey-black metamorphosed hornblende andesite.
