0	91.2	Overburden: 72' of water and 13.2' gravel and boulders.
91.2	99.1	Fine grained, medium green dolerite dyke with several small inclusions of the andesite underneath (99.1 - 197.6), as tilted to a varying degrees
99.1	197.6	Fine grained to very fine grained, dark bluish-green, altered and silicified andesite; with chlorite, cordierite, anthophyllite and local biotite developed. Occasional epidote nests and fracture fillings. Sparse quartz fracture-fillings near upper contact. Sparse pyrrhotite and pyrite specks. 116.2 - 117.3 Brecciated zone, filled with trap material. 167.2 - 170.4 Amygdaloidal horizon. 193.2 - 195.0 " "
197.6	216.5	Very fine grained, greenish-grey, altered and silicified andesitic tuff; with biotite and chlorite developed and large quartz crystals. Sparse pyrrhotite and pyrite specks.
216.5	235.5	Fine grained, dark bluish-green, altered and silicified andesite, similar to 99.1 - 197.6, but more siliceous; with some quartz crystals. Slight shearing? Some minor intercalated tuff bands. Sparse pyrite specks. 216.5 - 219.7 Amygdaloidal horizon.
235.5	248.0	Very fine grained, greenish-grey, altered and silicified andesitic tuff, similar to 197.6 - 216.5. Sparse pyrite specks. 238.0 - 239.0 ground core.
248.0	254.0	Very fine grained, dark bluish-green, altered and silicified andesite, similar to 99.1 - 197.6. Pyrrhotite and pyrite finely dispersed.
254.0	284.0	Fine grained, dark bluish-green, highly altered and silicified andesite, similar to 216.5 - 235.5, locally fractured and brecciated. Sparse pyrite and pyrrhotite specks. 257.0 - 260.0 ground core.
284.0	306.0	Very fine grained, greenish-grey, altered and silicified tuff, similar to 197.6 - 216.5. Locally finely banded and crenulated. Sparse pyrite and pyrrhotite specks.

From	To	Description
300.0	311.18	Fine grained, bluish-grey, altered and silicified andesite, similar to 254.0 - 284.0, with minor intercalated tuff bands. Sparse pyrite specks.
311.1	318.9	Very fine grained, greenish-grey, altered and silicified tuff, similar to 284.0 - 300.0.
318.9	325.0	Fine grained, bluish-grey, altered and silicified andesite, similar to 99.1 - 197.5, with amygdulose and small epidote blebs. 321.5 - 323.5 ground core.
