13.5	47.6	Andesite - Medium grey to black, fine grained intense chloritization, with bands of py throughout.
47.6	214.1	Andesite? - Medium to light grey, fine to medium grained, numerous quartz injections. Blebs of chlorite throughout and scattered epidote stringers. Similar in appearance to the grit on the 550 level.
214.1	235.5	Andesite - Medium grey to black, strong chlorite and cordierite. Moderate py mineralization. 233.5 - 235.5 intense chlorite, cordierite alteration, heavy po, py.
235.5	242.3	Andesite? - Medium to light grey, fine to medium grained, similar to 47.6-214.1. Only minor quartz injections.
242.3	246.3	Andesite - Same as from 214.1-235.5
246.3	251.5	Andesite? - Same as from 235.5-242.3
251.5	261.5	Andesite - Core badly broken, similar to chloritic andesite above, moderate py.
261.5	269.0	Tuff? - Medium to light grey, very siliceous, minor cordierite alteration. Specks of py throughout.
269.0	272.9	Tuff - Medium to light grey, very siliceous with moderate chlorite cordierite alteration, moderate quartz veining. Specks of py.
272.9	278.0	Dike - Medium to dark grey diorite, fine to medium grained texture.
