PLANNING ASSUMPTIONS, GUIDELINES AND EXPLANATIONS

Each Party holds a locked CD-ROM containing the digital data files. The Parties will, no later than each tenth anniversary of the Effective Date, cooperate to update their respective digital data files and the storage systems in which those files are maintained, so that each Party continues to hold an identical set of current, accessible, digital data files. In this section “digital data files” means the geospatial vector representations of the boundaries contained in the Map Atlas that are used to delineate the boundary locations that are shown in the Map Atlas and described in the Land Appendices.

FINAL AGREEMENT PROVISIONS

1.1.1 "Map Atlas" means the series of American National Standards Institute (ANSI) ‘D’ map sheets containing the maps that graphically represent the boundaries of lands illustrated in schedules 4-A, 4-B, 4-C, 4-D, 4-E, 4-F, 5-A, 7-B, 8-A, 9-A, 12-E, 17-A, 17-B, 17-C, 17-D and 17-E of the Agreement. Unless otherwise stated, these maps were created using the National Topographic Data Base (NTDB) 1:50,000 digital topographic base maps, and the digital data files depicting all boundaries as agreed by the Parties;
