Understanding an IM Program Plan

- Review definitions and concepts related to IM Program Plan

Review and Identify IM Drivers and Business Alignment Requirements

 Identify what is driving IM including the business, legal, regulatory and other compliance requirements as well as identify how the IM Program must align.

Perform Current State Assessment and set Goals and Objectives

 Assess how IM is currently functioning within the organization, identifying any gaps, deficiencies, lessons learned and opportunities for improvement. Set goals, objectives and priorities for IM to lay out what IM must do to support the business strategy, business operations as well as the organization's IM compliance.

Identify Services and Define Service Management Processes

 Identify what IM services (internal and external) will be provided.
Consider what IM projects and other IM activities and events will be undertaken as part of the IM Program, and outline how services will be delivered.

Plan Education and Awareness

 Determine what is already in place, what is necessary to development and what activities and events will be undertaken.

Define Resource Requirements

Determine what resources will be required to deliver the IM
Program, including people, funding and facilities.

Establish IM Program Management Framework (including Governance and Organization)

 How will the IM Program be managed and delivered, including resource allocation and management, and IM Service Delivery (including how decisions are managed).

Identify Performance Measurement and Reporting Requirements

 Identify and track how the program is progressing according to the plan, including how and when it will be communicated internally.

Obtain Program Plan Approval, Review and Updates

 The IM Program Plan must have approval from the IM Governance Body and lifecycle managed to reflect organization changes from internal and external sources.

Monitor and Verify

— Review and validate compliance, performance and capacity.
