Computer Systems Analyst I	Develops, installs, administers and maintains small to large scale information systems.
Computer Systems Analyst IA	Designs, develops and maintains geospatial databases.
Equipment Operator IIB	Operates a bus to transport students to and from school.
Equipment Operator II	Operates light and heavy trucks to pick up and deliver various items.
Homemaker	Performs standardized work in teaching basic life skills and assisting clients with integration into independent living within the community.
Homemaker C	Provides a range of supports and services to families receiving services through the Department of Child, Youth and Family Services.
Library Technician II	Non-supervisory
Library Technician IIA	Supervisory
Medical Records Technician I A	Accurate allocation of diagnostic and intervention codes and the collection of patient and hospital specific demographics on a patient's current episode of care.
Medical Records Technician I	Supports Provincial Cancer Registry by maintaining cancer and related dataset of the electronic information management system.

Medical Records Technician IID	Oversees operations of a technical division of the Health Records Department.
Medical Records Technician II	Assists in the day to day operations and participates in clerical, information mgmt. and transcription services of the Health Information Services and Informatics Division of the Cancer Centre.
Trades Worker IE	Journeyman Carpenter.
Trades Worker I	Maintenance, repair and troubleshooting work near the journeyman level in the building, mechanical, plumbing and electrical trades.
Trades Worker II	Journeyman level work in building mechanical, electrical or plumbing
Trades Worker IIA	Supervisory carpenter positions who supervise others engaged in carpentry work.
