

Livestock Insurance

Livestock insurance is a provincial program designed to provide insurance to compensate Newfoundland and Labrador producers for the death or injury of sheep, goats, dairy cattle or beef cattle caused by dogs or other predators. Producers who register their animals for insurance prior to April 1 of each year and pay the insurance premiums are covered until March 31 in the event any of their animals are killed or severely injured by a predator and need to be put down.

Application deadline is March 31, 2026
