

MESSENGER

Roles and Responsibilities



A Messenger is appointed on an as required basis by the Returning Officer.

The Messenger is responsible for:

- Ensure items are delivered as per the Returning Officers instructions in a timely manner.
- Pick up of items from various locations and returned to Returning Officer Office at the direction of the Returning Officer.

A Messenger must:

- Be 18 years of age or older.
- Reside in the electoral district in which they will be working.
- Have a valid driver's license.
- Have knowledge of the electoral district.
- Not have had political involvements 60 days prior to appointment.
- Remain completely impartial while employed by Elections Newfoundland and Labrador.
- Be able to react appropriately to problems and challenges.

A Messenger is paid as per the Schedule of Fees and reimbursed for milage as per Government of Newfoundland and Labrador's Automobile Reimbursement Rates for Using a Private Vehicle at Work.
