These statements shall include a balance sheet, statement of earnings and statement of cash flows, all prepared in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.

Pro-forma Financial Information

Pro-forma financial statements for four years shall be provided. Projected cash flows shall be prepared on a monthly basis for the first year and on an annual basis for the following three years.

Pro-forma balance sheets and statements of earnings shall be prepared on an annual basis for four years. All assumptions shall be stated.
