

2023 Cutting Provisions for Domestic Cutting Permit D0260-Trynor's Pit Forest Management District 02

- 1. The **Permittee**, or the "**Helper**" identified on permit, must have the cutting permit, map and conditions in his/her possession when cutting and/or hauling timber. The helper is responsible for all cutting operations when permit holder is not present.
- 2. **Domestic Harvest Area Boundaries:** The cutting of live trees is not permitted outside the boundaries identified on maps associated with this specific Domestic Cutting Permit.
- 3. **Special Condition for Top Diameter:** The Permittee must utilize all portions of all trees harvested to a top diameter of **5 cm** (2 inches. All portions of a tree must be utilized at time of harvest before the next tree is harvested.
- 4. **Sawlogs:** Timber with a top diameter of 5 inches (12.7 cm) or greater shall be considered as sawlogs, unless defective (crooked, split, forked, rotten, etc).
- 5. **Storage near Public Highways:** Wood is not to be piled less than 10 m from the driving surface of the public highway.
- 6. **Silviculture Areas:** The Permittee shall not cut, or in any way damage, immature or silviculturally treated timber.
- 7. **Water Buffers:** No cutting is permitted within 30 meters (98 feet) of any stream or body of water and 100 m (330 ft) of **scheduled salmon rivers**.
- 9. **Logging Debris in Water Bodies:** The felling or deposition of trees, parts of trees, and any logging debris into streams or water bodies is strictly prohibited.
- 10. **Designated Trail Buffers:** No cutting is permitted within 30 meters (98 feet) of designated recreational trails identified on domestic area maps.
- 11. **NL T'railway:** No cutting is permitted within 100 metres (330 ft) of the Provincial T'Railway. Extraction of timber, utilizing vehicles other than an approved off-road vehicle, will require a "Temporary Vehicle Access Permit" from The Department of Environment and Conservation.
- 12. **Licence to Occupy:** This permit allows the cutting of timber in areas identified on a valid "Licence to Occupy" that has been issued to the domestic permit holder.
- 13. **Roadside Cutting:** This permit allows the cutting of deadwood and blowdown within 100m (330 ft) of a public highway. Cutting of live trees within 100m of highway is prohibited.
- 14. **Deadwood and Blowdowns:** This permit allows the cutting of deadwood and blowdown outside designated domestic harvest blocks but not within areas designated for no harvest activity or scheduled commercial harvesting areas.
- 15. **Powerlines:** No cutting is permitted within 6 meters (20 ft) of any powerline.
- 16. **Fuel Handling:** Fuel must be stored in CSA approved containers. Refuelling must not take place within 30 m of any water body. Used motor oil must not be used as chain lubricant.
- 17. **Waste** must be removed from the site.

Public Protected Water Supply Areas (PPWSA)

When operating within PPWSAs identified on the attached domestic map, the permittee shall comply with all **Special PPWSA Conditions**

- a) No cutting within 150 meters of Shoal Harbour River for 1 km of the intake
- b) No cutting within 100 meters of the remainder of Shoal Harbour River
- c) No cutting within 50 meters of major tributaries, lakes and ponds
- d) No cutting within 30 meters of other water bodies
- e) Motorized vehicles, including snowmobiles and ATV's shall not be used to cross the frozen surface of the intake pond.
