The Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture - Forestry and Wildlife Branch – will be carrying out a Spruce Budworm Control Program at various sites in western Newfoundland and on the Northern Peninsula beginning in late June 2023.

Daily Update Information:

There was no spray activity carried out last evening (July 2) or this morning (July 3)

Assessments of insect development conducted over the week indicate that the following spruce budworm treatment blocks are now ready for treatment with the first application of the biological control product Btk. Subject to weather conditions, treatment will begin in the designated treatment Blocks 100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 108 and 122 North of Gros Morne. Blocks 210 and 214 east of Gros Morne.

Daily updates will be provided throughout the duration of the program.
