The Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture - Forestry and Wildlife Branch – will be carrying out a Spruce Budworm Control Program at various sites in western Newfoundland and on the Northern Peninsula beginning in late June 2023.

Daily Update Information:

Aircraft being used as part of the 2023 Spruce Budworm Control Program began arriving in the province on June 20th, 2023 and are positioned at Deer Lake and Port aux Choix Airports in preparation for the start of treatment activity. Treatments are expected to begin over the next week, subject to weather and insect development. Daily updates will be provided once treatment activity begins.
