The Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture - Forestry and Wildlife Branch – will be carrying out a Spruce Budworm Control Program at various sites in western Newfoundland and on the Northern Peninsula beginning in late June 2023.

Daily Update Information:

Treatment block 303 located south of Gros Morne received treatment this morning (June 24) and is now complete.

Assessments of insect development conducted over the week indicate that the following spruce budworm treatment block is now ready for treatment with the first application of the biological control product Btk. Subject to weather conditions, treatments will begin in the designated treatment block 117 located north of Gros Morne.

Daily updates will be provided once treatment activity begins.
