The Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture - Forestry and Wildlife Branch – will be carrying out a Spruce Budworm Control Program at various sites in western Newfoundland and on the Northern Peninsula beginning in late June 2023.

Daily Update Information:

There was no treatment activity carried out last evening (June 29).

Blocks 302, 303, 305 and 306 south of Gros Morne were treated this morning (June 30) and are now complete. Block 304 south of Gros Morne received a partial treatment this morning (June 30).

Assessments of insect development conducted over the week indicate that the following spruce budworm treatment blocks are now ready for treatment with the first application of the biological control product Btk. Subject to weather conditions, treatment will begin in the designated treatment Block 104 north of Goss Morne. Blocks 204, 205 and 206 east of Gros Morne.

Daily updates will be provided throughout the duration of the program.
