The Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture - Forestry and Wildlife Branch – is advising the public that the department will be carrying out a Spruce Budworm Early Intervention Program on the west coast of Newfoundland beginning in the middle of June 2021.

Daily Update Information:

Assessments of insect development conducted over the week indicate that the following spruce budworm treatment blocks are now ready for treatment with the first application of the biological control product B.t.k. First applications are scheduled to commence on the evening June 11, subject to weather conditions. Treatments will begin in the designated treatment blocks 320, 321, 322 and 323 located south of Gros Morne National Park and 400, 401, 402, 403, 404, 412, 414 and 415 located south of the Bay of Islands.

Daily updates will be provided once treatment activity begins.
