Treatment blocks 321 and 322 (South of Gros Morne National Park) received a full first application of the biological control product B.t.k and treatment block 323 (South of Gros Morne National Park) received a partial first application of the biological control product B.t.k last evening Monday, June 14. No treatment activity occurred this morning, June 15, due to weather conditions.

Subject to weather conditions, treatments are scheduled for today, Tuesday, June 15, in the following locations:

- South of Gros Morne National Park - Treatment Blocks 316 and 317
