The Department of Fisheries, Forestry and Agriculture - Forestry and Wildlife Branch – is advising the public that the department will be carrying out a Spruce Budworm Control Program on the west coast of Newfoundland beginning in the middle of June 2022.

Daily Update Information:

No treatment activity took place last evening (June 18) or this morning (June 19) due to weather conditions.

Assessments of insect development conducted over the week indicate that the following spruce budworm treatment blocks are now ready for treatment with the first application of the biological control product Btk. Subject to weather conditions, treatments will begin in the designated treatment blocks 315 and 316 located south of Gros Morne National Park.

Daily updates will be provided throughout the duration of the program.
