**Daily Update Information:**

Treatment blocks 245, 246, 247, 248, 260, 261 and 262 east of Gros Morne National Park received treatment the morning of June 26. Treatment blocks 322, 323, 324, 333, 335, 338, 342, 349 and 350 south of Gros Morne National Park received treatment the morning of June 26. Treatment blocks 403, 404, 405, 406, 424, 425, 436, 437, 517, 520, 525, 528, 530, 531, 533, 534 and 536 south of Corner Brook received treatment the morning of June 26. Treatment block 275 east of Gros Morning National Park received treatment the evening of June 26. These blocks have received one complete application of Btk. Treatment block 346 south of Gros Morne National Park received a partial treatment the morning of June 26. Treatment block 206 received partial treatment on the evening of June 26.

Daily updates will be provided throughout the duration of the program.
