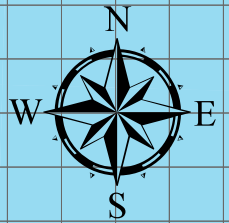

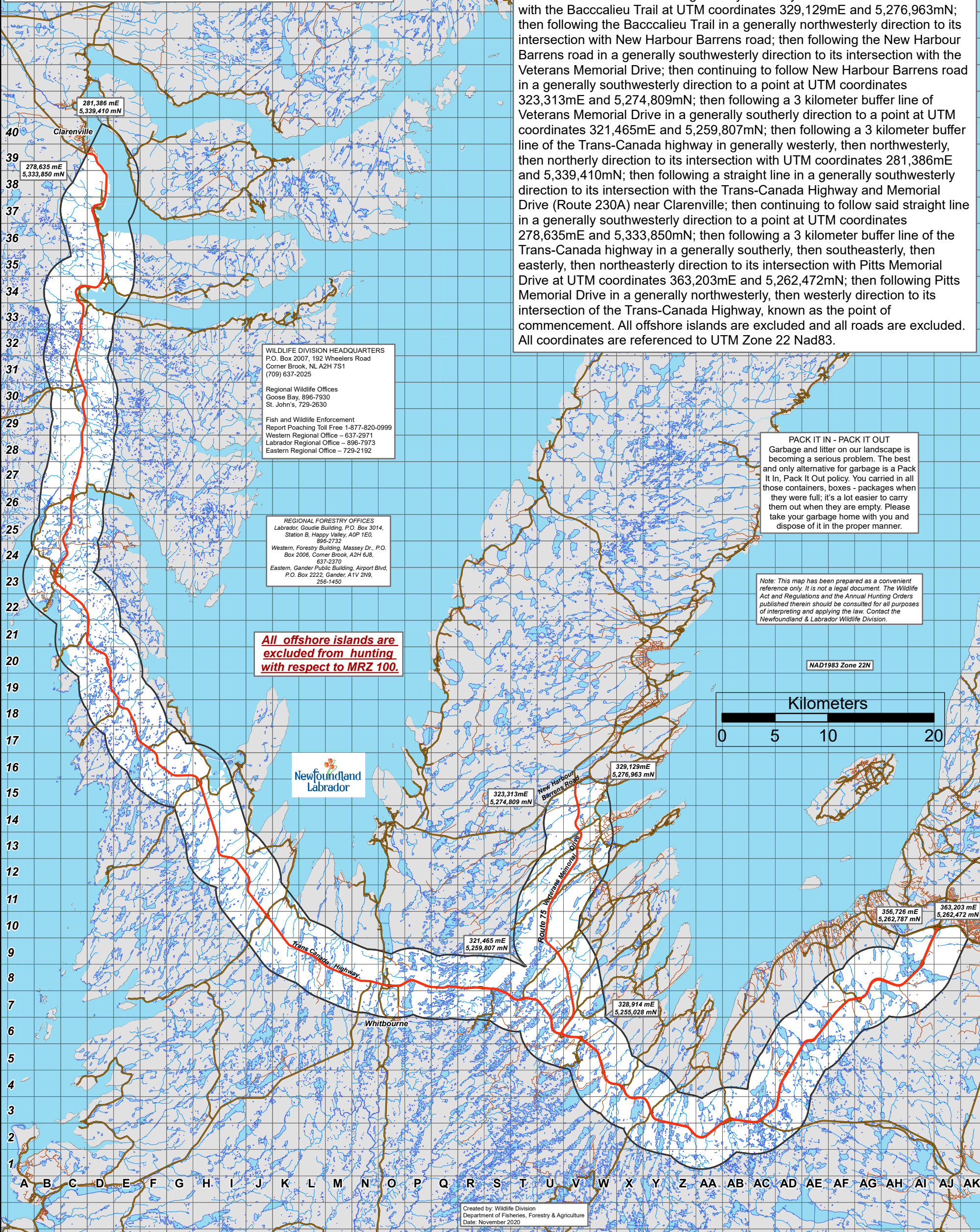

Moose Reduction Zone (MRZ) 100

All that area of the Island of Newfoundland commencing at the intersection of the Pitts Memorial Drive and the Trans-Canada Highway; then following Pitts Memorial Drive in a generally westerly by southwesterly direction to a point at UTM coordinates 356,726mE and 5,262,787mN; then following a 3 kilometer buffer line of the Trans-Canada highway in a generally southwesterly, then westerly, then northwesterly direction to a point at UTM coordinates 328,914mE and 5,255,028mN; then following a 3 kilometer buffer line of Veterans Memorial Drive in a generally northerly direction to its intersection with the Bacccalieu Trail at UTM coordinates 329,129mE and 5,276,963mN; then following the Bacccalieu Trail in a generally northwesterly direction to its intersection with New Harbour Barrens road; then following the New Harbour Barrens road in a generally southwesterly direction to its intersection with the Veterans Memorial Drive; then continuing to follow New Harbour Barrens road in a generally southwesterly direction to a point at UTM coordinates 323,313mE and 5,274,809mN; then following a 3 kilometer buffer line of Veterans Memorial Drive in a generally southerly direction to a point at UTM coordinates 321,465mE and 5,259,807mN; then following a 3 kilometer buffer line of the Trans-Canada highway in generally westerly, then northwesterly, then northerly direction to its intersection with UTM coordinates 281,386mE and 5,339,410mN; then following a straight line in a generally southwesterly direction to its intersection with the Trans-Canada Highway and Memorial Drive (Route 230A) near Clarenville; then continuing to follow said straight line in a generally southwesterly direction to a point at UTM coordinates 278,635mE and 5,333,850mN; then following a 3 kilometer buffer line of the Trans-Canada highway in a generally southerly, then southeasterly, then easterly, then northeasterly direction to its intersection with Pitts Memorial Drive at UTM coordinates 363,203mE and 5,262,472mN; then following Pitts Memorial Drive in a generally northwesterly, then westerly direction to its intersection of the Trans-Canada Highway, known as the point of commencement. All offshore islands are excluded and all roads are excluded. All coordinates are referenced to UTM Zone 22 Nad83.
