Important Instructions

- 1. The producer must submit a completed form to the NL Crop insurance Agency. If the producer is requesting an inspection for re-seeding benefit the form must be received before the re-seeding deadline of that particular crop (see above). A request to abandon form must be received by August 15, 2024. All other inspection requests must be received before the harvesting deadline.
- 2. You must not abandon, destroy, reseed or use the seeded acreage for another purpose without notice to or consent of the Agency in writing.
- 3. If loss or damage occurs and it appears that the potential production of the crop will be less than the guaranteed production, you must notify the agency within such time as to permit a pre-harvest inspection.
- 4. Advise the agency if you are unable to complete harvesting prior to the final date for harvesting as set forth in the endorsement application to the damaged crop.
