Daily Update Information (July 4):

Part of Block 205 - Batteau Barrens, part of Block 208 – Brian's Pond, part of Block 212 – East of Portland Creek and part of Block 214 – Parsons Pond were treated last evening (July 5) with Btk.

Part of Block 209 – Portland Creek / Inner Pond, part of Block 212 – East of Portland Creek and part of Block 214 – Parsons Pond were treated this morning with Btk.

The following blocks have now been fully treated with the first application:

Block 205 – Batteau Barrens, Block 206 – Zink Mine, Block 210 – Portland Creek, Block 211 – The Arches, Block 215 – Three Mile Rock and Block 216 – Parsons Pond.

Additional information and updates will be provided on a daily basis as spray activity continues.
