

ISLAND POND RIDGE

All that area of Newfoundland bounded by beginning at the intersection of the Island Pond Ridge forest access road and the Trans Canada Highway, TCH, Route 1 at UTM coordinates 336825 meters east 5244570 meters north: following a straight line in a generally northeasterly direction southwestern extremity of Georges Pond at UTM coordinates 337880 meters east and 5246165 meters north; following the western shoreline of Georges Pond in a generally northerly, then northeasterly direction to the mouth of an unnamed stream at coordinates 338000 meters east and 5246975 meters north; then following the northeastern bank of the unnamed stream in a generally northwesterly direction to Gull Pond; then following the northeastern shoreline of Gull Pond in a generally northwesterly direction to its northern extremity at UTM coordinates 337780 meters east 5247305 meters north; then following a straight line in a generally westerly by northwesterly direction to a stream at the southwestern extremity of a unnamed pond at UTM coordinates 336790 meters east and 5247620 meters north; then following the eastern bank of the unnamed stream in a generally southwesterly. northwesterly, direction to Island Pond at UTM coordinates 336580 meters east and 5247565 meters north; then following the eastern shoreline of Island Pond in a generally southerly direction to its southern extremity at UTM coordinates 336550 meters east and 5246405 meters north; then following a straight line in a generally south by southeasterly direction to its intersection with the Island Pond Ridge forest access road at UTM coordinates 336750 meters east and 5245840 meters north; then following the Island Pond Ridge forest access road in a generally southerly by southwesterly, then generally southeasterly direction to the point of commencement.
