

Tobacco Retailer Inventory Return Labrador Border Zone Rebate Change

Labrador Border Zone Tobacco Retailers are required to report their inventory of cigarettes and tobacco (other than cigarettes and cigars) as of 12:01 am, April 1, 2023 using the table below. In the event the retailer does not carry any inventory, a "NIL" return must be filed.

As this inventory will not be sold until after the change in the effective tax rate, it will be subject to rebate at the rates in effect as of April 1, 2023. The Department of Finance will use the information in this return to make any necessary adjustments for subsequently filed rebate applications.
