RE: Standing Fish Price-Setting Panel – Minimum Shrimp price Summer, 2026

I write on behalf of the Standing Fish Price-Setting Panel (the “Panel”). In accordance with section 19.11 (1) of the *Fishing Industry Collective Bargaining Act* (the “Act”), the Panel conducted a hearing into the price of Shrimp for the Summer 2026 season. We received submissions from both FFAW and Association of Seafood Producers.

We understand that while there is no “Minister’s date” by which we must render a decision, the current collective agreement in place between these parties is due to expire on June 21, 2026.

Therefore, the panel provides this letter to advise that it has selected the proposal brought by FFAW and hereby sets the price of Shrimp as follows for the Summer 2026 season:
