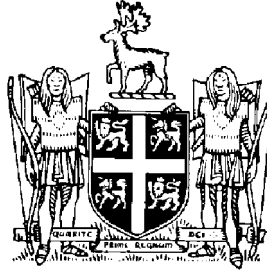

Short title

**1.** This Order may be cited as the *Forest Fire Season Order, 2026*.

Forest fire season

**2.** The forest fire season for 2026 shall be

- (a) between the hours of 12:01 a.m. on May 1, 2026 and midnight on September 30, 2026 on the island portion of the province; and
- (b) between the hours of 12:01 a.m. on May 15, 2026 and midnight on September 30, 2026 on the Labrador portion of the province.

**1. Section 7 of the *Child and Parental Benefits Regulations* is repealed and the following substituted:**

Benefit reduction  
calculation

**7.** Where the adjusted income of an eligible individual for a base taxation year, in relation to a month

- (a) is less than or equal to \$20,397, the benefit reduction "E" shall equal zero; and
- (b) is greater than \$20,397, the benefit reduction "E" shall be calculated by multiplying the difference between the adjusted income and \$20,397 by
  - (i) 10.61% where there is one qualified dependent,
  - (ii) 21.86% where there are 2 qualified dependents,
  - (iii) 33.94% where there are 3 qualified dependents, and
  - (iv) the total of 33.94%, and the product obtained by multiplying the number of qualified dependents in excess of 3 by 12.98%.

**1. Paragraph 3(c) of the *Income Supplement and Seniors' Benefit Regulations* is amended by**

**(a) deleting the amount "\$1,516" wherever it appears and substituting the amount \$1,882"; and**

**(b) deleting the amount "\$29,402" and substituting the amount "\$30,409".**

**2. Section 3.1 of the regulations is amended by renumbering it as subsection 3.1(1) and adding immediately after subsection (1) the following:**

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1), indexation required under that subsection shall not be carried out for the 2026 taxation year.
