The Buildings Accessibility Advisory Board is appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council under the authority of Section 18 of the **Buildings Accessibility Act**. The board consists of a Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, representatives of persons with disabilities, one representative from the Department of Government Services, other than the Director of Engineering and Inspection Services, and other members that may be appointed by the Provincial Government. There are currently seven members on the board. This public body, which is funded by the Department of Government Services, serves solely in an advisory capacity.
