

The Newfoundland and Labrador PRESCRIPTION DRUG ASSURANCE PLAN

Through a new program announced in Budget 2007, those with very high prescription drug costs can receive assistance, based on income levels. Recent improvements to this plan mean that now more people than ever are eligible for assistance.

Here's an example of how the Assurance Plan coverage is determined:

A family with an annual income of \$35,000 and annual drug costs of \$6,000 requires a maximum contribution per year of 5% of their income, which is \$1,750.

How we calculate your co-payment:

 $($35,000 \times 5\%)/$6,000 = 29.17\%$

Each time a prescription for an eligible benefit is filled, the family will pay 29.17% of the total cost of the prescription.

IF YOUR FAMILY NET INCOME IS	YOUR ELIGIBLE PRESCRIPTION DRUG COSTS FOR THE YEAR WILL BE CAPPED AT
\$39,999 or less	5% OF YOUR FAMILY NET INCOME
\$40,000 - \$74,999	7.5% OF YOUR FAMILY NET INCOME
\$75,000 - \$149,000	OF YOUR FAMILY NET INCOME
