- 2. Section 3 of the regulations is amended by renumbering it as subsection 3(1) and by adding immediately after subsection (1) the following:

- (2) For greater certainty, the medically necessary removal and replacement of a cataractous lens by any procedure is an insured service and shall be performed in a hospital or a facility designated by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council.
