Children in Newfoundland and Labrador must be secured in a booster seat, when travelling in most vehicles, if they:

- are four to eight years old (inclusive)
- weigh between 40 and 80 pounds (18 and 37 kilograms) and,
- are 4'9" (145 cm) tall or less.

A properly installed and appropriately used booster seat can reduce the risk of injury to children by 70% and the risk of death by 90%.
