







9.) Can you access most routine healthcare services close to/ near where you live? (Multiple Choice)







12.) I have acceptable access to primary healthcare providers when I need them. (Multiple Choice)










21.) My primary health care providers communicate well with each other regarding my care (Multiple Choice)


