Note that a licence covers both the spring and fall black bear seasons for 2021 only. Application deadlines must be met in order to guarantee receipt of your licence before the season opens. Applications that are received after these deadline dates will not guarantee a licence is processed or mailed before the season opens. Please do not include this application with a moose or caribou application. If you intend to hunt black bear in more than one management area you must submit a separate application by photocopying this form or print extra forms from our website at: https://www.gov.nl.ca/ffa/licenses-permits-and-fees/w-license/.
