fall black bear hunting seasons throughout Newfoundland and Labrador is June 30, 2022. Applications received after these deadlines may experience delays in receipt of your licence. Note that licences are valid for both the spring and fall black bear seasons for 2022. If you intend to hunt black bear in more than one management area you must also submit a separate application by photocopying this form or print extra forms from our website at: https://www.gov.nl.ca/ffa/licenses-permits-and-fees/w-license/.
