
- Recovery continues ... in Canada, at least

- Rare metals in vogue






#### **Gross Value of Mineral Shipments by Commodity**








### Mining Industry Average Employment - now at a 20 year high -


- Recovering from recession building production to 4.05 mt

- Production restarted but substantially below normal levels




### Commercial Nickel Processing Plant - Long Harbour -

- On track for completion in early 2013















### Julienne Iron Project



- Crown-owned iron resource that is currently EML (Exempt Mineral Land)
- Currently (November 2010) being drilled ~ 8000 m as part of a \$2.1 million budget




- Aim is to provide a better resource estimate prior to any decision as to how to proceed further with the deposit
- Previously estimated to contain about 460 mt

- Part of Budget 2010
- Release of Discussion Paper pending
- Will be followed by public and industry consultations





#### Outlook 2011-2012

- Continued recovery
- Continued growth of iron ore sector with IOC expansion & 2 new iron mines
- Re-opening of the Ming and possibly St. Lawrence mines
- 4 new mines: ~ 600 direct jobs
- Peak construction at Long Harbour site
- Gold and rare metal projects attracting increased attention; copper stays strong
