


## THE MATTY MITCHELL PROSPECTORS RESOURCE ROOM

## **Activities for 2008**

The Matty Mitchell Prospectors Resource Room project is currently in its tenth year of operation. Principal objectives of the Room are to provide technical and promotional



assistance and mentoring to prospectors across Newfoundland and Labrador. In 2008, the Resource Room provided in excess of one hundred individual clients, on multiple visits, with on-site information and consultation services, including rock and mineral identification, help with data interpretation, presentation, property promotion and technical advice. Others were assisted via telephone and/or email

consultations and through seminars and prospecting courses. Despite the downturn in the economy in 2008, prospectors continued to stake new properties and option agreements were signed between at least 18 prospectors, individually or as groups, with junior exploration companies.



The Resource Room supplied property promotional services and technical and logistical support to clients at the Exploration Roundup, Vancouver, PDAC, Toronto, and Annual Review of Activities, St. John's, trade shows. We developed, displayed and distributed

prospector property posters and Properties for Option maps, booklets and CD-ROMs, and joined with the Survey in developing



promotional and regional technical posters for these major industry conferences. The Resource Room helped prospectors to follow up contacts made at the industry conferences.



The Matty Mitchell geologist participated in a one-day careers fair in Bay Roberts and also helped to prepare and deliver a two day prospecting course in St. Lawrence, on the Burin Peninsula. The Matty Mitchell Room also made presentations to the eighteenth annual Prospectors course in Stephenville and to the third annual Labrador Prospectors course which was held in Happy Valley-Goose Bay, in July.









These various projects were part of the Matty Mitchell Room's public outreach initiative, working in conjunction with the Chamber of Mineral Resources and the Mineral Development Division of the Department of Natural Resources. We acknowledge the support provided by the public and private sector geologists in this and other initiatives over the course of 2008.



The Resource Room continues to develop outreach initiatives to promote itself and its services to the public. As part of our website development, we have added a "Links of Interest" page, which has links to other websites with information on Matty Mitchell and items of geological interest. We also maintain a web page which will contains information on properties available for option from Prospectors.


