Molecular Genetics Laboratory Specimen Collection Instructions						
To prevent avoidable delays or cancellation of testing, use the checklist below to ensure						
specimen type, volume, day of collection, and shipping are correct.						
Specimen volume requirements						
Peripheral blood						
Bone marrow						
Instructions for all specimens						
□ Specimens MUST be accompanied by a completed requisition. DO NOT collect specimens without						
a completed requisition.						
□ Use potassium EDTA lavender-top vacutainer(s) for specimen collection. Other vacutainers will						
be rejected.						
□ Mix specimen after draw. DO NOT centrifuge.						
□ Confirm a minimum of two matching personal identifiers on the vacutainer that match the						
requisition. Specimens without a minimum of two matching personal identifiers will be rejected.						
□ Clearly indicate collection date and time on the vacutainer and requisition. Specimens and						
requisitions without collection date and time will be rejected depending on test ordered**.						
□ Clearly indicate the mnemonic of the healthcare professional collecting the specimen on the						
vacutainer.						
□ Pack specimens with a matching requisition separately in a biohazard bag. If multiple						
specimens and requisitions are packed in the same biohazard bag, all specimens will be rejected.						
□ Ship specimens at room temperature or 4 degrees as soon as possible on day of collection						
using priority shipping.						
□ DO NOT freeze specimens for shipping.						
□ Specimens should arrive at the testing laboratory within 48 hours from time of collection.						
Specimens arriving after 48 hours will be rejected depending on test ordered**.						
**Special instructions for RNA-based testing (APL: PML/RARA; CML/ALL: BCR/ABL1)						
□ Collect specimens Monday-Wednesday inclusive. Specimens that arrive after 12PM on Friday						
will be rejected.						
□ Include most recent complete blood count (CBC) report and send with specimen and completed						
requisition.						
Ship specimens (with requisitions) priority overnight
