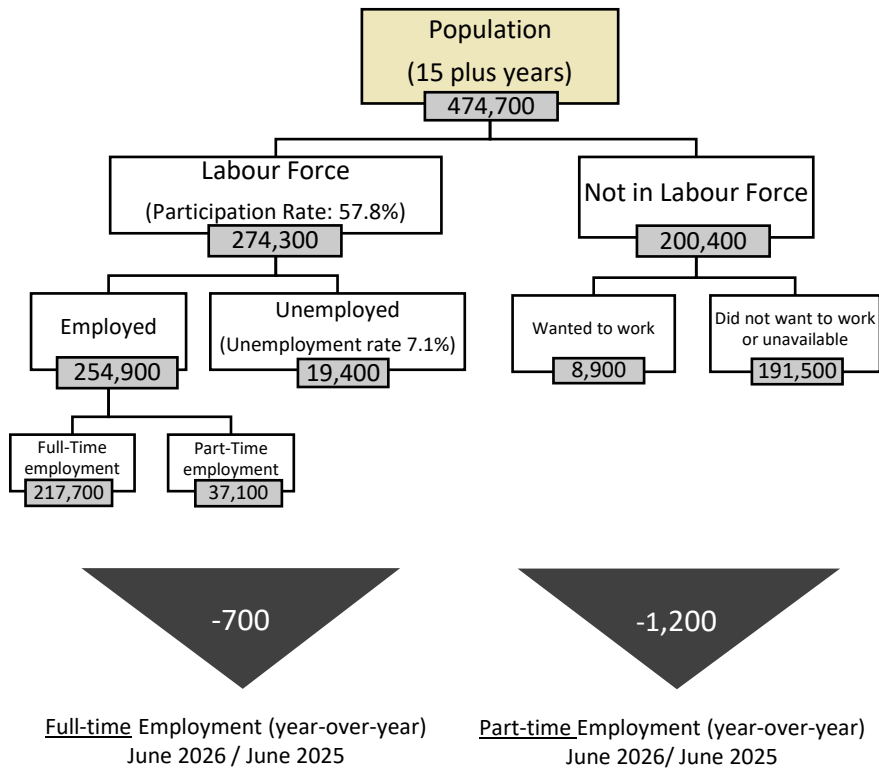


NL LABOUR MARKET INFORMATION



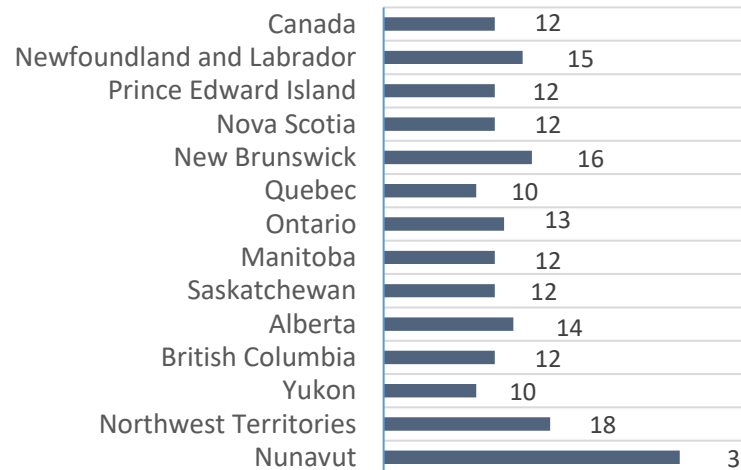
- Unemployment remained decreased by -16.0% (or -3,700) year-over-year (June 2026 compared to June 2025).
- Employment decreased year-over-year (-1,800 people, or -1.8%).

DATA SPOTLIGHT

Percentage of 15 to 29 Year Olds Not in Employment, Education or Training (NEET) in 2025

- The province with the highest percentage of 15-to-29 year olds in NEET during 2025 was New Brunswick (16 per cent) followed by Newfoundland and Labrador (15 per cent).
- The jurisdictions with the lowest percentage of NEET in 2025 were Quebec and the Yukon Territory (at 10 per cent each). Both were lower than the national percentage of 12 per cent.
- The jurisdiction with the highest percentage of NEET in 2025 was Nunavut at 32 per cent, almost three times the percentage for Canada overall.

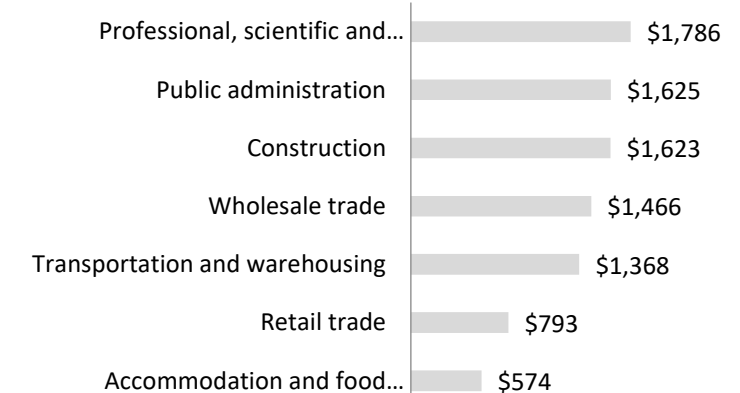

Average Weekly Earnings | April 2026

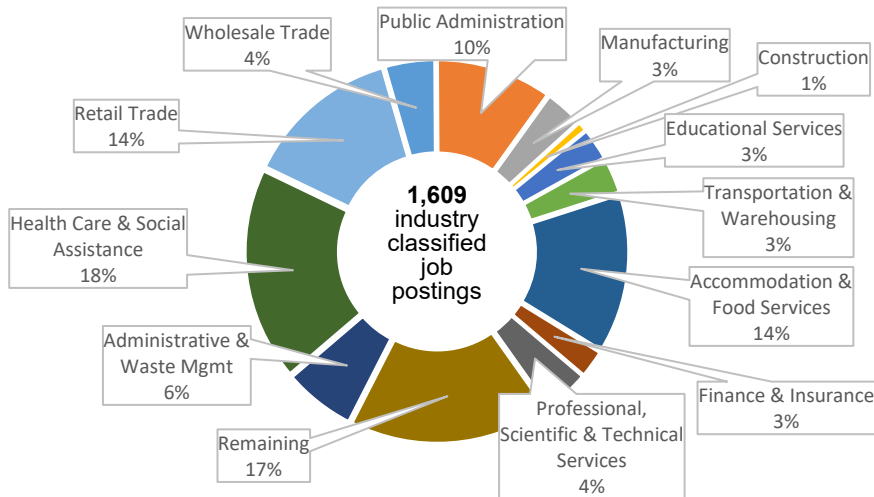


NL average wage increased year over year by +\$19.23 (+1.5%)

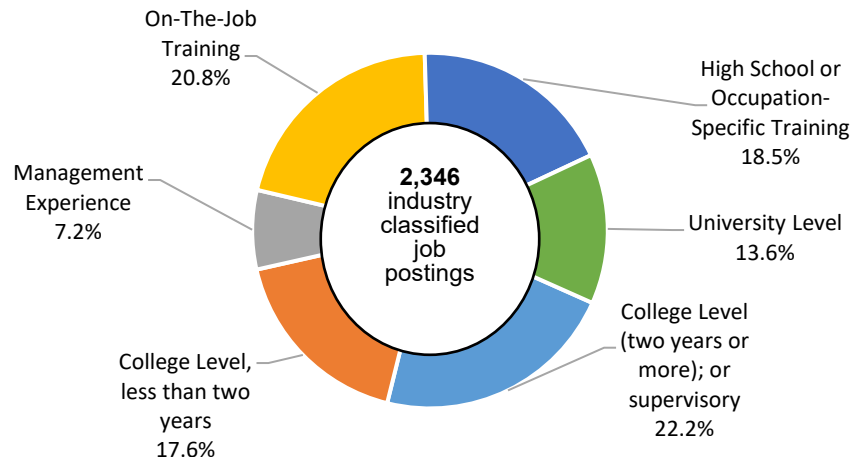
Average Weekly Earnings, Select NL Industries April 2026
