CIRCULAR TO MUNICIPALITIES MUNICIPAL CONDUCT ACT REMINDER MANDATORY TRAINING

February 2023

As a requirement of the **Municipal Conduct Act** (the Act) and **Municipal Conduct Regulations** (the **Regulations**), that was proclaimed and came into effect on September 1, 2022, councillors and chief administrative offers, as defined in the Act, are required to complete the following mandatory training:

- · roles and responsibilities of councillors and chief administrative officers;
- meetings and procedures of council;
- budgets and financial management;
- information related to access to information and protection of privacy; and
- conflict of interest.

Councillors and chief administrator officers shall complete mandatory orientation training within one year of the Act coming into force (September 1, 2023), or 60 days of being sworn or affirmed into office. As per section 21 (3) of the Act, a councillor or chief administrative officer who does not attend the orientation training within the time period prescribed shall not carry out a power, duty or function as a councillor or chief administrative officer until the training has been completed.

Please note, municipalities can arrange their own mandatory training, in relation to the above, as long as the trainer has received certification from the Department. Consultants who wish to provide mandatory orientation training can apply to the Department of Municipal and Provincial Affairs for approval. Requests, including the training materials to be used and qualifications, should be submitted to Kim MacPherson, Manager of Municipal Training Programs at kimmacpherson@gov.nl.ca. Approved training providers will be notified in writing of their approval.
