Re: Ultimate Recipient Gas Tax Agreement Revision

Please be advised, effective July 21, 2020, within the Ultimate Recipient Gas Tax Agreement, Schedule A, Paragraph 14 has been deleted and replaced with the following:

“Submit a Capital Investment Plan to the Province for proposed eligible projects within the same calendar year that construction is initiated.”

The original Schedule A, Paragraph 14 indicated a Capital Investment Plan must be submitted to the Gas Tax Secretariat before construction was started. With this revision recipients are now able to submit a Capital Investment Plan for a proposed eligible project after the project has started but it must be within the same year construction is initiated (i.e. a project started in 2019 must be approved in 2019). It is still highly recommended you seek approval from the Gas Tax Secretariat before the project has started whenever possible.
