TOWN OF GLOVERTOWN MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT No. 10, 2021

BACKGROUND

The Town of Glovertown wishes to amend its Municipal Plan to give Council discretionary authority to permit agricultural tourism uses in the Rural designation. Council will consider an application to develop an agricultural tourism use only where the proposed use will be subsidiary to an existing agricultural use.

For the purposes of this amendment, agricultural tourism will fall into the following categories: agricultural education (e.g., school visits to a farm), hospitality (overnight farm stays), recreation (e.g., animal petting, horseback riding, assisting with farm chores), and entertainment (e.g., hayrides, harvest dinners, catering).

The amendment will apply to the Rural Resource and Agriculture zones within the Rural Resource designation.

The Glovertown Urban Hen Regulations are attached.

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Public notice (see attached) of the proposed amendment was posted on March 1, 2021, providing a period for comments to March 16, 2021.

In response to the notice, one submission only was received from Alisa and Hardy Watkins (see attached). Their letter expressed concern that the amendment could possibly result in an increase in farm animals on an existing farm in proximity to their home.

MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT No. 10, 2021

Amendment No. 10 to the Glovertown Municipal Plan includes the following change.

1. <u>Section 4.2.9.1 – Rural Resource (page 27)</u> ADD the following policy statement:

"Policy RR-4A It shall be a policy of Council that agricultural tourism may be permitted as a subsidiary use to existing agriculture operations."

2. <u>Section 4.2.9.3 – Agriculture (page 28)</u> ADD the following policy statement:

"Policy RR-9 It shall be a policy of Council that agricultural tourism may be permitted as a subsidiary use to existing agriculture operations."
