# TOWN OF LEWISPORTE DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT No. 18, 2013

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Town of Lewisporte proposes to amend its Development Regulations. Lewisporte is slowly running out of available land for future residential development. The Town has taken an aggressive approach to identify lands for future development to encourage a planned and comprehensive development, rather than the application driven approach. A site has been identified to the west of Pleasant Street and south of Range Road which has suitable conditions for residential development. Services will be extended as development phases require and the area will eventually be fully serviced.

The Lewisporte Land Use Map has these areas zoned as Industrial Light and Open Space Recreation. The purpose of this Amendment is to re-zone these lands from Industrial Light to Residential Medium Density and Open Space Recreation to Residential Medium Density.

The Pleasantview Seniors Home, located at the end of Pleasant Street, is proposing an expansion to the south. A small area of land will be re-zoned from Open Space Recreation to Residential Senior Citizens.


#### **PUBLIC CONSULATION**

During the preparation of this amendment, Council undertook the following initiative so that individuals and groups could provide input to the proposed Development Regulations Amendment. The Town Council of Lewisporte published a notice in *The Pilot* newspaper on September 18, 2013, advertising the proposed amendment to consider comments, objections and representations from the public. The Town Council also placed the proposed amendment on display at the Town Council Office from September 18 to September 25, 2013, for residents to view and to provide any comments or concerns in writing to the Council concerning the proposed amendment. No verbal or written comments were received.

### **DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT No. 18, 2013**

The Town of Lewisporte Development Regulations is amended by:

- A) Changing an area of land from "Industrial Light" to "Residential Medium Density",
- B) Changing an area of land from "Open Space Recreation" to "Residential Medium Density", and
- C) Changing an area of land from "Open Space Recreation" to "Residential Senior Citizens", as shown on the attached copy of the Town of Lewisporte Land Use Zone Map
