## **MUNICIPAL PLAN AMENDMENT No. 2, 2019**

### BACKGROUND

The Town of Springdale proposes to amend its Municipal Plan to change the Future Land Use designation of approximately 20 hectares of land from Rural to Residential. The site is located on Boyles Hill between Little Bay Road and Main Street. The amendment was requested by a local land developer for the development of a residential subdivision.

### PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Public notice (see attached) of the proposed amendment was posted on April 17, 2018 providing a period for comments to 3:00 pm on April 29, 2019. The notice was posted on the Town's website (www.townofspringdale.ca) and on bulletin boards in the following locations:

- 1. Coleman's Grocery 162 Main street
- 2. Foodland Grocery 169 Main Street
- 3. Town Office 151 Main Street

No comments were received in response to the public notice.


Because the land in question has a history of quarry activity, the proposed amendment was submitted to the Mineral Lands Division for comments. No written comments were received, however, the regional Mineral Lands Compliance Officer obtained a voluntary release of the single active quarry permit within the area and indicated the Division has no objection to the amendment. This was confirmed to the Town Manager by Gerald Kennedy, Manager of Quarry Materials with the Mineral Lands Division. As requested by Mr. Kennedy, the Town sent him a letter (see attached) indicating the Town would no longer provide quarry permits in the affected site.


