



Text Only

For Print Materials: Use CMYK-TIFF files.
For Social Media: Use RGB-PNG or JPEG files.
For Web Materials: Use RGB-PNG or JPEG files.

The manufacturers of printed merchandise can determine the best file format to use.

Don't:

Of course, there are some things that our logo was never meant to do. Let's ensure consistency in all applications by avoiding the misuses on this page.



Don't stretch the logo.



Don't recolour the logo.



Don't change the proportion of logo elements.



Don't rotate or shear the logo.



Don't change the logo to feature strokes.



Don't apply effects (embosses or shadows) to the logo.



Don't rearrange the logo elements.



Don't remove elements from the logo.



Minimum Protection Space

To ensure legibility, the logo must stand out and not be cluttered with competing elements. This is achieved by surrounding the logo with clear space that is kept free of any type or distracting graphics.

The minimum protection space required on all sides of the logo is equal to the width of the "E" from the Come Home 2022 wordmark.

This area is to always remain clear of colour, imagery or other elements.
