

TOURISM SNAPSHOT

YTD DECEMBER 2021

HIGHLIGHTS


- Provincial tourism performance continued to improve throughout 2021 across a range of indicators. The number of non-resident visitors to NL reached 181,305 in 2021, a 57% increase compared to 2020 but still 62% below pre-pandemic 2019 levels. Auto visits were 68% above 2020 levels, but remained 31% below those recorded in 2019. Visits by air increased 52% over 2020, but remained 69% lower than in 2019.
- For the period since the re-opening of the province to travel from the rest of Canada in July 2021, visitation increased 152% relative to the July to December period of 2020. Visitation in the month of December was 256% above levels recorded in December 2020. marking significant year-over-year growth. It was another particularly strong month for auto visitation as levels surpassed those recorded in pre-pandemic 2019 for the fourth consecutive month (Sept-Dec). Air visitation was also strong in December, up 354% over December of last year but it remained well below December 2019 levels.
- Visitation to Provincial Historic Sites (PHS) and Provincial Visitor Information Centres (VICs) rebounded from 2020, up 124% and 198%, respectively. Despite these gains, visitation levels to PHS remained 67% below 2019 levels while VICs recorded 63% fewer visitors than in 2019.
- The licenced accommodations sector available YTD November) continued to see improvements over 2020 levels, with the occupancy rate (+10.2 pts), room nights sold (+46%) and total room revenue (+55%) all up over the same period last year. Despite these significant improvements, key sector indicators remained below pre-pandemic levels to close out the year.
