Re: Removal of Project Signs after project completion

Date: July 24, 2026

The Department of Transportation and Infrastructure provides cost shared funding to communities for capital works projects throughout the province. Project Signs are an important visual representation of NL's financial commitment, along with the commitment of our Federal and Municipal funding partners, to these priority projects.

Project Signs are eligible costs through the funding programs, and per the funding agreements, they must be installed before the start of construction **and remain until one month after construction** has been completed. MI often hears of signs remaining in place for months post-project, which should not be the case.

Should your community have project signs in place more than one month post project completion, please have them removed and disposed of.
