P3 - Poor U - Uninspectable Condition: Bearings:

- Whole bearing area needs to be cleaned of road gravels and vegetation. Most of bearing area could not be seen Comments:

and therefore, was not inspected. The concrete in its vicinity was in great condition. - East abutment on roadway needs repair. Concrete disintegrated with top mat of rebar showing (P3). With this exception abutment, F2.
