- Wingwalls, exterior bearings in good condition. Both bearing seats have heavy gravel build up at the mid-point, Comments:

F2. Abutments have light erosion to waterline concrete. Interior bearings too high for inspection but condition

assumed to be the same as exterior.

G - Good F2 - Fair Condition: **Expansion Joints:**

- Expansion joint seals full of gravel, no water seen on bearing seats. Embedded steel starting to show through Comments:

surface concrete. Recommend replacing rubber seals with asphaltic plug joints as structure is on a gravel road. -Six girders have moderate corrosion to all surfaces. All interior braces are painted with light corrosion to bolts. Girders over abutments and have light paint chips likely caused from installation. Bottom of deck concrete in

excellent condition. Superstructure G.
