Comments: - East abutment and wingwalls in good condition, limited access for inspection. - West abutment has light map

cracking to the back wall and on both wingwalls. Both bearing seats have extreme gravel build up from the roadway. Both footings poured on bedrock. Suspect scour under the east abutment and the northwest corner of

the west abutment footing due to currents and lack of rip-rap protection.

SUPERSTRUCTURE

Comments: - Stringers/girders/horizontal bracing) have heavy gravel build up on flanges. Most panel sections do not have

galvanized pins and have moderate corrosion. Otherwise the members/connections are in fair condition. - No
